With your continued support, Norwalk High School will continue to be a leader in the educational field — we are innovative while at the same time traditional. It's a wonderful mix.





The Junior Prom. What can we say but that there was more overflowing than just excitement.


The new government finally got under way by mid-February with plans to keep in operation until June.


Well it's now March of the senior year and we can't wait to graduate. The slump is here (since November, no doubt) and seniors are looking forward to jobs, college, and the new frontier.
